I have already provided a statement to PIRC in relation to my involvement in the death of Sheku Bayoh on 3 May 2015 in Kirkcaldy.

I have been asked regarding the Gold Group meeting of 1130 hours on 3 May 2015 and in particular about whether it was discussed that officers would provide statements regarding their involvement. I don't recall this at the meeting, but what I didn't previously mention is that I went to the canteen sometime before the Gold Group meeting and before Chief Inspector Conrad Trickett arrived, to speak to the officers. This was purely for welfare purposes.

WITNESS STATEMENT

There were two Federation Representatives present along with the full compliment of officers involved in the incident, including Nicole Short.

I have been asked about the initial death message which was given to the family and the form of words used. I recall speaking to DS Dursley regarding officers who had attended at and that the family were wanting to know more information. I advised DS Dursley to speak to Detective Superintendent Campbell and to see what information could be provided to the family to update them surrounding the circumstances.

A short time later two CID officers came back to Kirkcaldy Police Office and I spoke to them with Chief Inspector Nicola Shepherd. I wanted to try and understand what was happening in the family environment and the impact on the local community. They advised me that their visit had little positive impact so I decided that myself and Nicola Shepherd would attend and speak to the family.

I have been shown the

decision 23, which relates to a form of words for the cause of death which could be passed to family and police officers. There was a meeting between Detective Superintendent Pat Campbell and PIRC during which this was discussed. I wasn't present.

Detective Superintendent telephoned myself with the form of words and also sent written confirmation that it had been agreed with PIRC.

I was at Glenrothes Police Station. My intention was to attend at Kirkcaldy Police Office and pass the form of words to the officers. I telephoned the P.I.O. Stevie Kay the T/Inspector who advised me that the officers had finished for the day and had left the office. I asked Stevie Kay to contact each officer individually and deliver the form of words to them. I also sent the form of words electronically to make sure the message was accurate.

At no time during this investigation have I been involved in the matter around the provision of statements by officers. My focus has been staff welfare, community tension and reassurance and providing support when and where I can to Sheku Bayoh's family.
